Henare works in acrylic paint on canvas, relishing the versatility and rich palette of colors which the medium offers her.



Drawing occasionally from hundreds of photographs, she looks for the essence of her scenes, creating images rooted more within the feeling of a landscape than in its physical forms.

Raised in Auckland, New Zealand, Helene Henare now lives and works in a converted barn on the scenic, rural outskirts of the city.

A recent addition to the art world, she has received much attention as an emerging artist in recent years, drawing attention from publishers, authors and collectors both in her native New Zealand and worldwide.
